Content and strategies of the course :

This course allows French teachers to immerse themselves in pedagogy and more particularly in classroom animation techniques.

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How to motivate learners and adapt to teenagers

Creating a functional and cooperative class group, maintaining and stimulating motivation.

Teaching mistakes: how to correct them?

Understanding the value of mistakes in learning. Knowing how to communicate about mistakes so that they are not perceived as a 'penalty'. Diversify your correction techniques.

Working on learners' phonetics and pronunciation

Incorporate short phonetics activities into the classroom sequence. Use the verbo tonal method for remediation.

Explore different classroom dynamics

Differentiate classroom methods to encourage oral production: collaborative work, flipped classroom, etc.

Project work: the action approach

Find out more about action-based teaching and incorporate it into your teaching practices. Put learners in a position to act, by giving them tasks and projects to develop individually or in groups.

Through 5 workshops, we will explore a range of techniques to motivate learners, correct them, offer various activities throughout the year and different class modalities within the same course.

Thanks to interactive workshops, mixing exchanges of practices with the group and pedagogical proposals from our trainers, you will discover different classroom animation techniques. This course offers an active pedagogical approach. After doing case studies, you will put into practice the skills acquired in each workshop.
